BY THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL of County Hall Glenfield
Leicester LE3 8RA (hereinafter called "the County Council") to
BOTTESFORD PARISH COUNCIL acting for the time being of The Old
School, Grantham Road, Bottesford, Nottingham NG13 0DF (hereinafter
called "the Parish Council")

WHEREAS the County Council) is the Highway Authority for the parish of
Bottesford and now hereby grants consent to the Parish Council shall install
and thereafter maintain Village Sign and a Heritage Board within the public
highway subject to the provisions OF Section 72 of the Road Traffic
Regulation Act 1984 and of the further conditions and stipulations set out in
this Consent which are deemed to apply to the Village Sign and Heritage
Board as may be the case, which are-

1. The Village Sign and Heritage Board shall only be installed at the
locations shown road on the plan attached to this Consent being at
 1. Rectory Lane, Normanton – outside St Marys Church –
Heritage Board.
 2. Normanton Lane, Normanton at its junction with Main Street
– Village Sign
2. The Village Sign and Heritage Board shall be of a design and
specification approved by the County Council's Area Manager and
shall not be varied or modified without the further approval of the
County Council

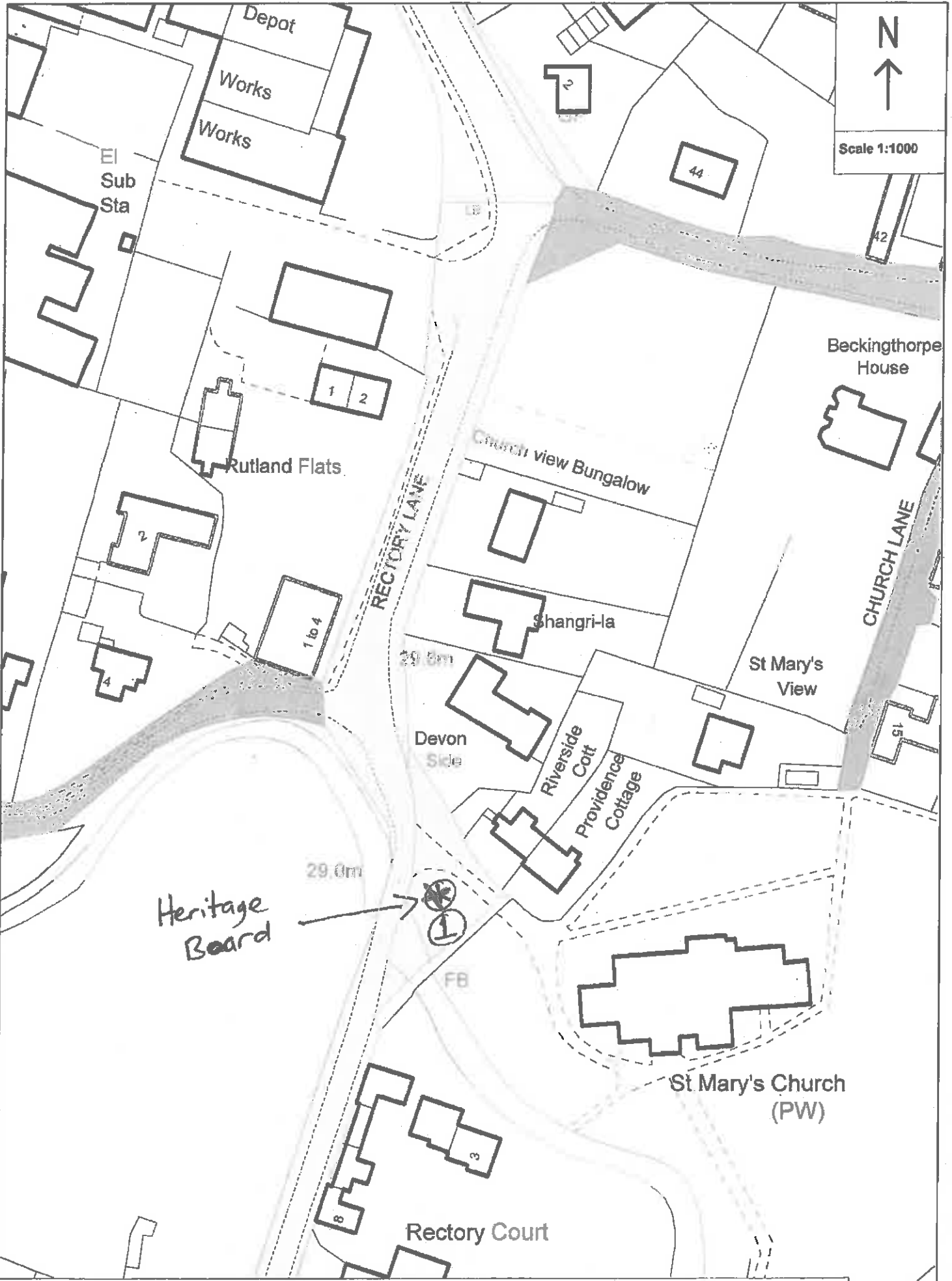
3. The Village Sign and Heritage Board shall be installed in a workmanlike manner without unnecessary damage to the highway which, if required, shall be reinstated to a like standard and to the satisfaction of the County Council
4. The Village Sign and Heritage Board shall be maintained to a good and satisfactory condition so as not to be a nuisance or hazard to any person or user of the highway and in the event that the Village Sign and Heritage Board requires repair or modification then the Parish Council shall carry out such reasonable requirements that the County Council acting by its Area Manager may indicate in writing, within 14 days of such notification.
5. The Parish Council hereby indemnifies the County Council in respect of any costs, claim or damages whatsoever including personal injury arising out of the installation and maintenance or lack of it of the Village Sign and Heritage Board except to the extent that any such claim arises from the actions of the County Council itself or its agents servants or officers
6. The Parish Council shall maintain a suitable Insurance Policy in the minimum sum of £5 million in respect of any claims arising from the provision of the and shall, if required, afford the County Council sight of the Policy
7. This Consent shall commence on the Twenty Fifth day of January 2016 and may be terminated by the County Council giving at least 28 days notice to the Parish Council or by the Parish Council surrendering the Consent whereupon the Parish Council shall make arrangements for the Village Sign and Heritage Board to be removed and the highway reinstated to the reasonable satisfaction of the County Council

And the County Council acting by its County Solicitor and the Parish Council have signed this Consent both the County Council and the Parish Council intending to be bound by it

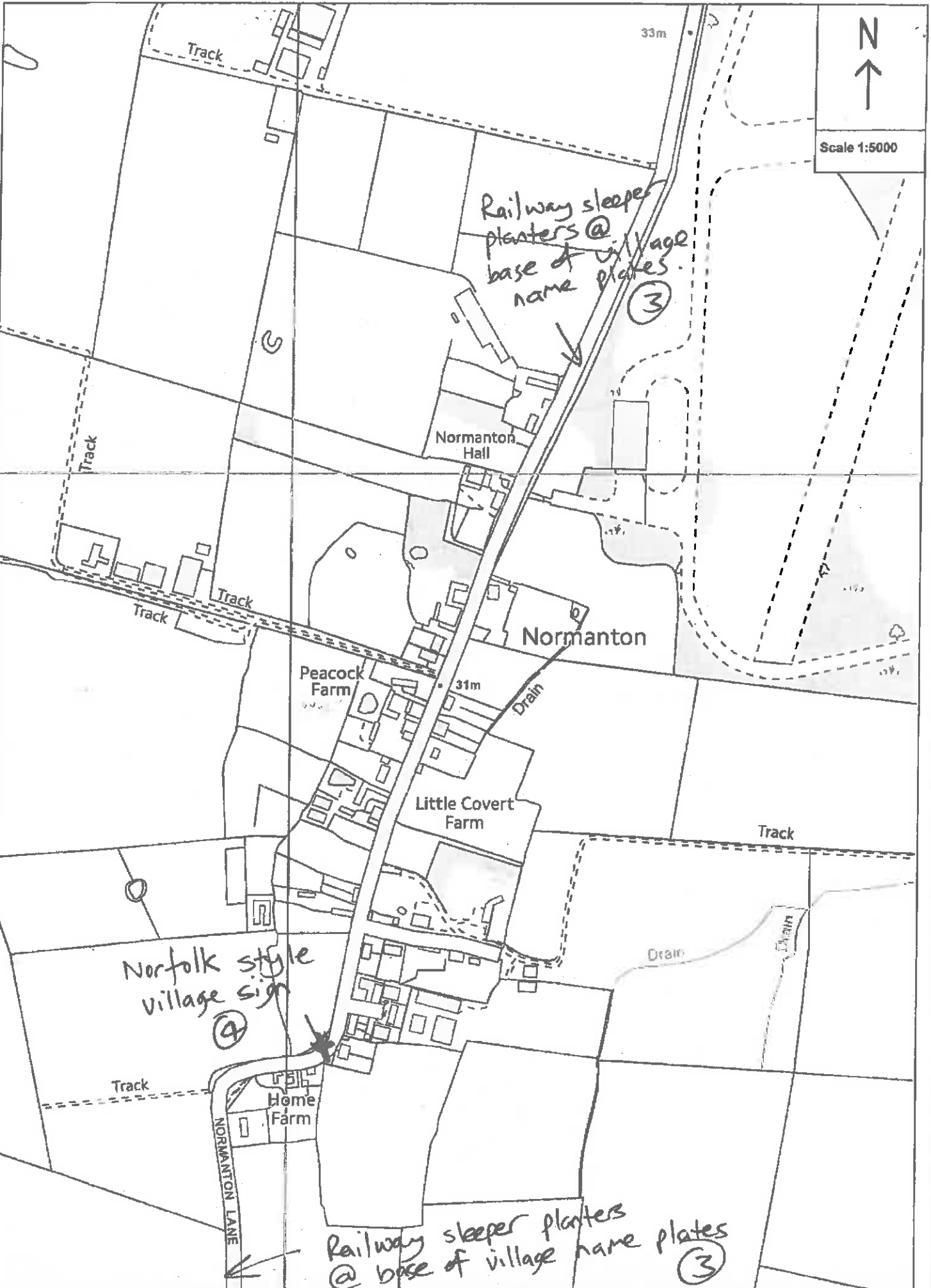
