Wireless Hotspot Terms of Service and Acceptable Use Policy

ACCESS

This wireless hotspot service is a free service provided in good faith by Bottesford Parish Council for members, staff and temporary guests of Bottesford Parish Council only. Your access to the service is completely at the discretion of Bottesford Parish Council, and your access to the service may be blocked, suspended, or terminated at any time for any reason including, but not limited to, violation of this Agreement, actions that may lead to liability for Bottesford Parish Council, disruption of access to other Users or networks, and violation of applicable laws or regulations. Do not reveal your account details to anybody else. Bottesford Parish Council may revise this Agreement at any time. You must accept this Agreement each time you use the Service and it is your responsibility to review it for any changes each time.

ACCEPTABLE USE

Bottesford Parish Council supports the free flow of information and ideas over the Internet. Your access to the Service is conditioned on legal and appropriate use of the service. Your use of the Service and any activities conducted online through the service shall not violate any applicable law or regulation or the rights of Bottesford Parish Council, or any third party.

The use of the Service for the following activities is prohibited,

Disrepute: Any activity which might damage the reputation of the Council, its employees or members is prohibited.

Spamming and Invasion of Privacy: Sending of unsolicited bulk and/or commercial messages over the Internet using the Service or using the Service for activities that invade another's' privacy.

Intellectual Property Right Violations: Engaging in any activity that infringes or misappropriates the intellectual property rights of others, including patents, copyrights, trademarks, service marks, trade secrets, or any other proprietary right of any third party.

Also, activities that disrupt the use of or interfere with the ability of others to effectively use the Node or any connected network, system, service, or equipment.

Other Illegal Activities: Using the Service in violation of applicable law and regulation, including, but not limited to, advertising, transmitting, or otherwise making available ponzi schemes, pyramid schemes, fraudulently charging credit cards, pirating software, or making fraudulent offers to sell or buy products, items, or services.
