

Lead Member Structure

The PC has a Lead Member system which allocates areas of focus for Councillors so that they can, between meetings, investigate issues more deeply and consult with relevant and interested parties. Whilst they make no decisions, Councillors are expected to bring back suggestions and recommendations to Parish Council for consideration.

In addition, there are two Parish Council **Committees**: one for **Planning** Matters, and one for **Road Safety** Matters. Each Committee has its own Terms of Reference and targets and reports recommendations to Parish Council.
