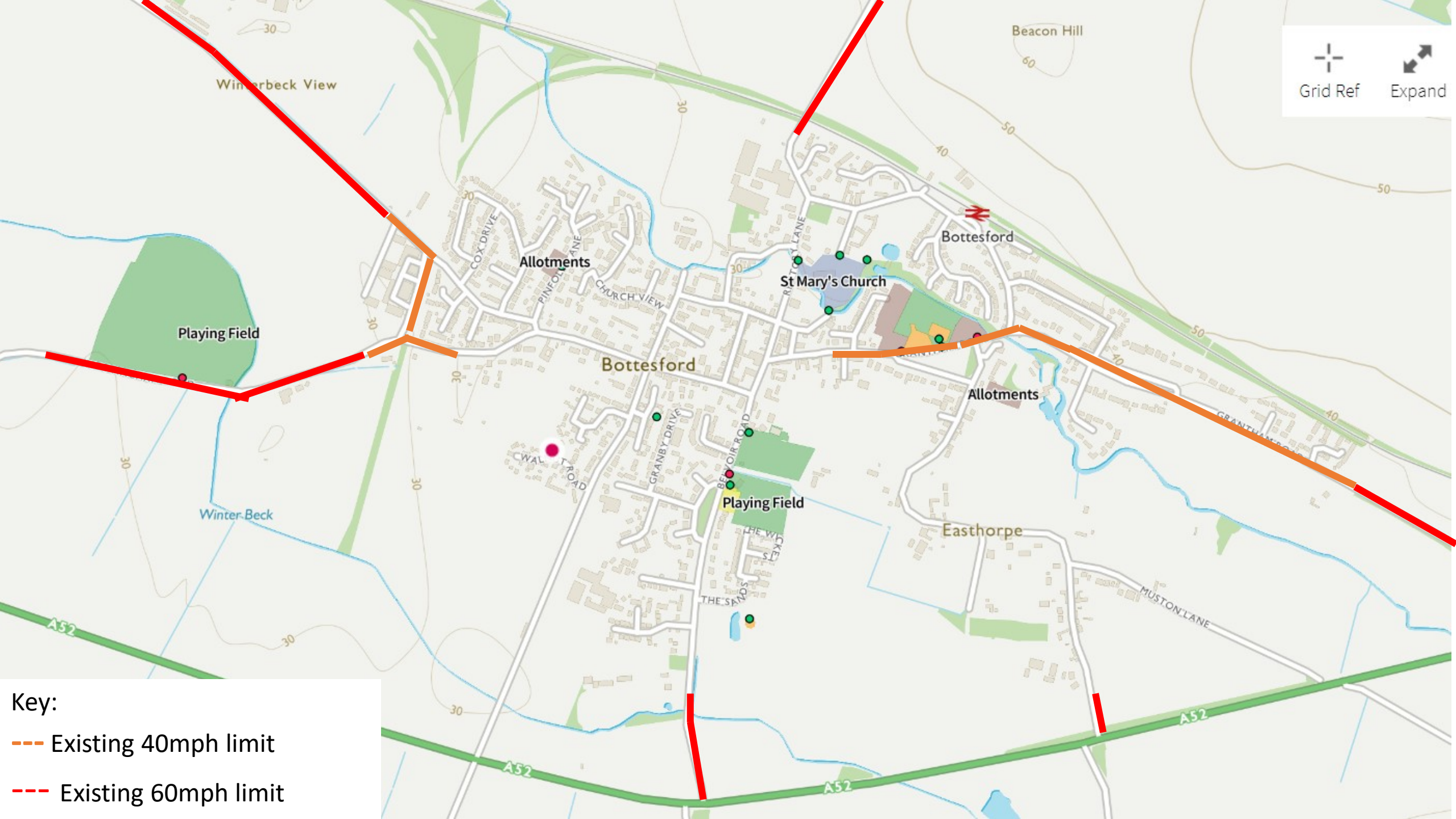

Summary of Changes

- 1) Extension of current 40 mph limit on Nottingham Road to extend to the football club playing fields. Increased risk due to volume of cars, cars parked on the road verge and pedestrian traffic.
- 2) Extension of 30mph limit to the existing 60/40mph sign on Nottingham Road. This is to allow for the increase in traffic movements on Bottesford industrial area and their access to the dangerous junction between Longhedge Lane and Nottingham Road. There will also be an increase in traffic movements with the proposed Rectory Farm development.
- 3) Extension of 30mph limit to the existing 60/40mph sign on Orston Lane. This is to allow for the increase in traffic movements on Bottesford industrial area. Also the increase in traffic movements with the proposed Rectory Farm development.
- 4) Extend the current 30mph limit to the just beyond the entrance to the new Miller homes development on Normanton Road. The entrance currently sits within a 60mph zone.
- 5) Extend the 30mph limit on Grantham road to the current 60/40 mph sign. This is to allow for the large number of new homes being built on this road and the policy of the parish to promote cycling into the village centre
- 6) Extend the current 30mph limit in Belvoir Road to just past the bridge over the winterbeck. This is a dangerous narrow bridge in a 60mph area. There is also a popular footpath crossing this road in the 60mph area.
